# OfD is...

- In operation since 2005
- A reaction to demand for Norwegian experiences and competence
- Based on cooperation directly between related governmental institutions



# OfD is...

- In operation since 2005
- A reaction to demand for Norwegian experiences and competence
- Based on cooperation **directly between related governmental institutions**
- Not export of “Norwegian model”, but sharing experiences and adaptation to local conditions

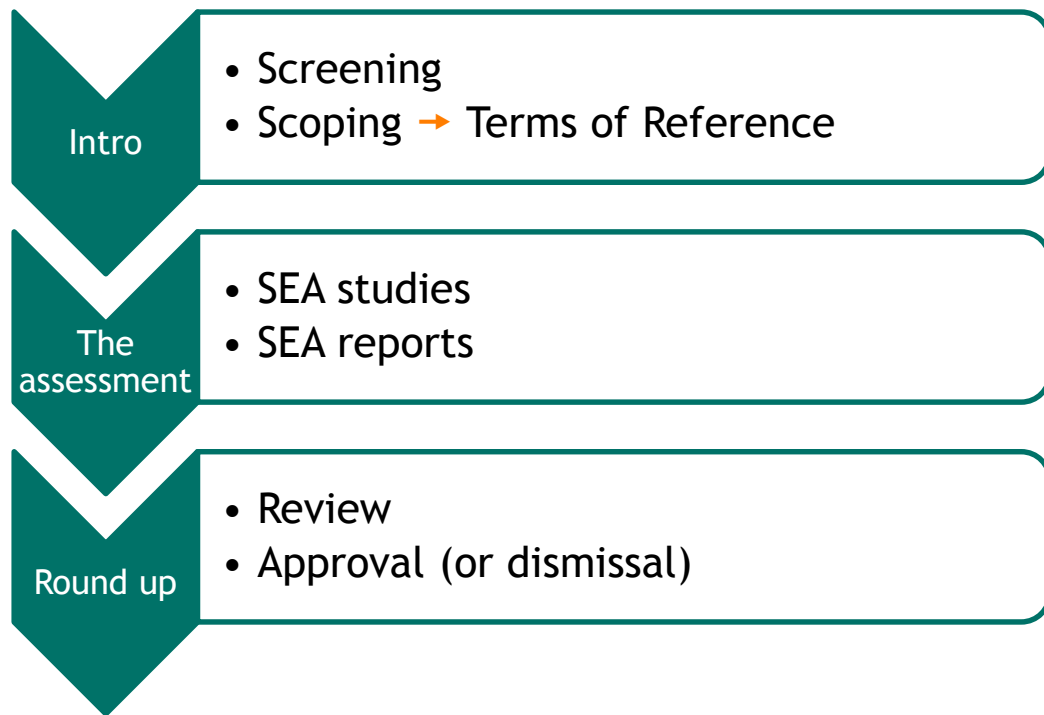
