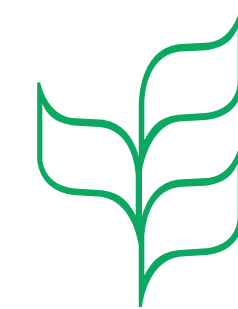




# High level messages

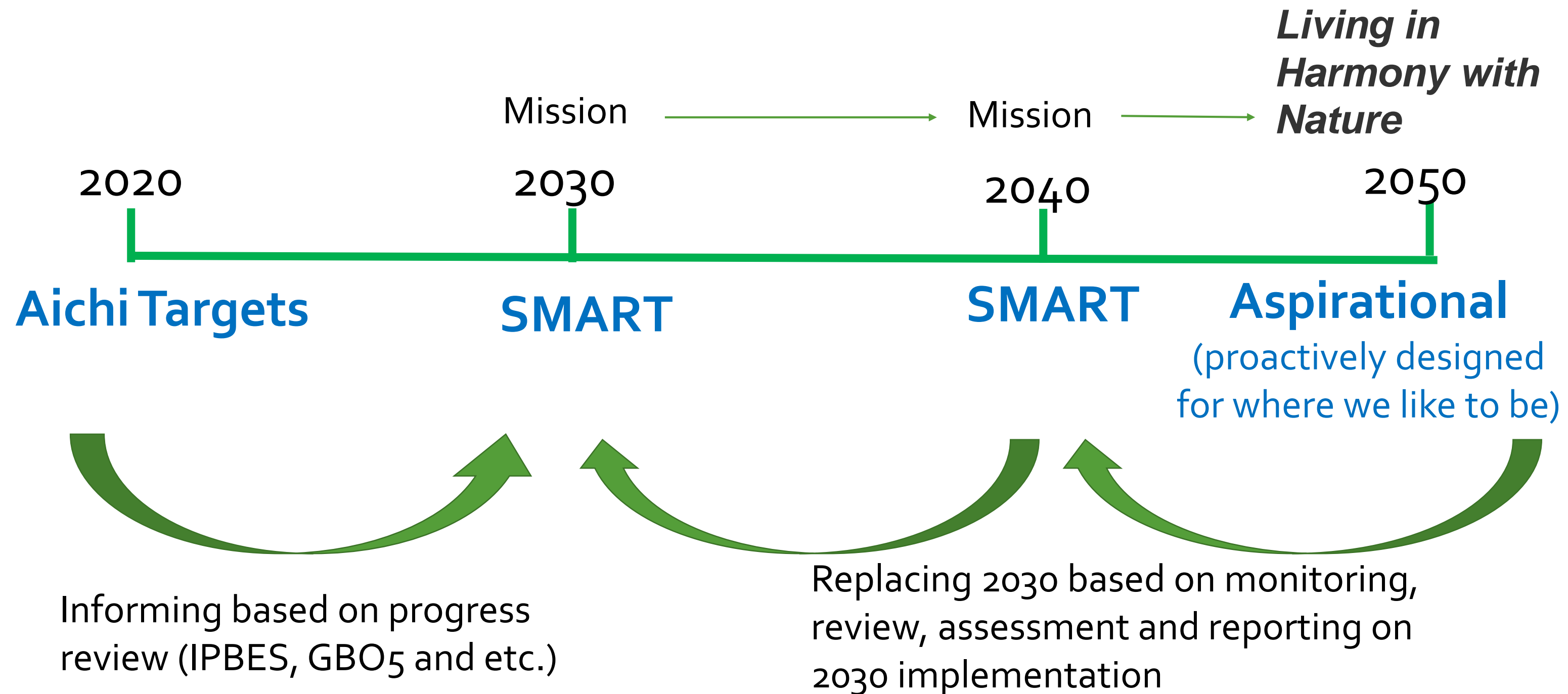
- Keep the **2050 vision** and unfolding to a practical level
- Address all **3 objectives** of the CBD
- Link every component of the framework to the vision
- **SDGs** implementation tool
- Global **NOT** a CBD framework
- Engage **all players** (include their goals)
- Unify **ALL** CBD Parties / stakeholders (common global goals) – with flexibility in national implementation
- Clear **narrative** to facilitate **communication**
- To be built on **Aichi targets**, SDGs and other processes

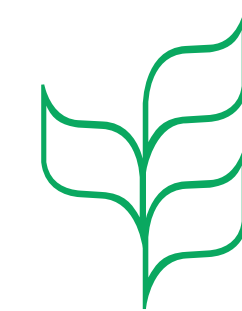
# Post-2020 global biodiversity framework

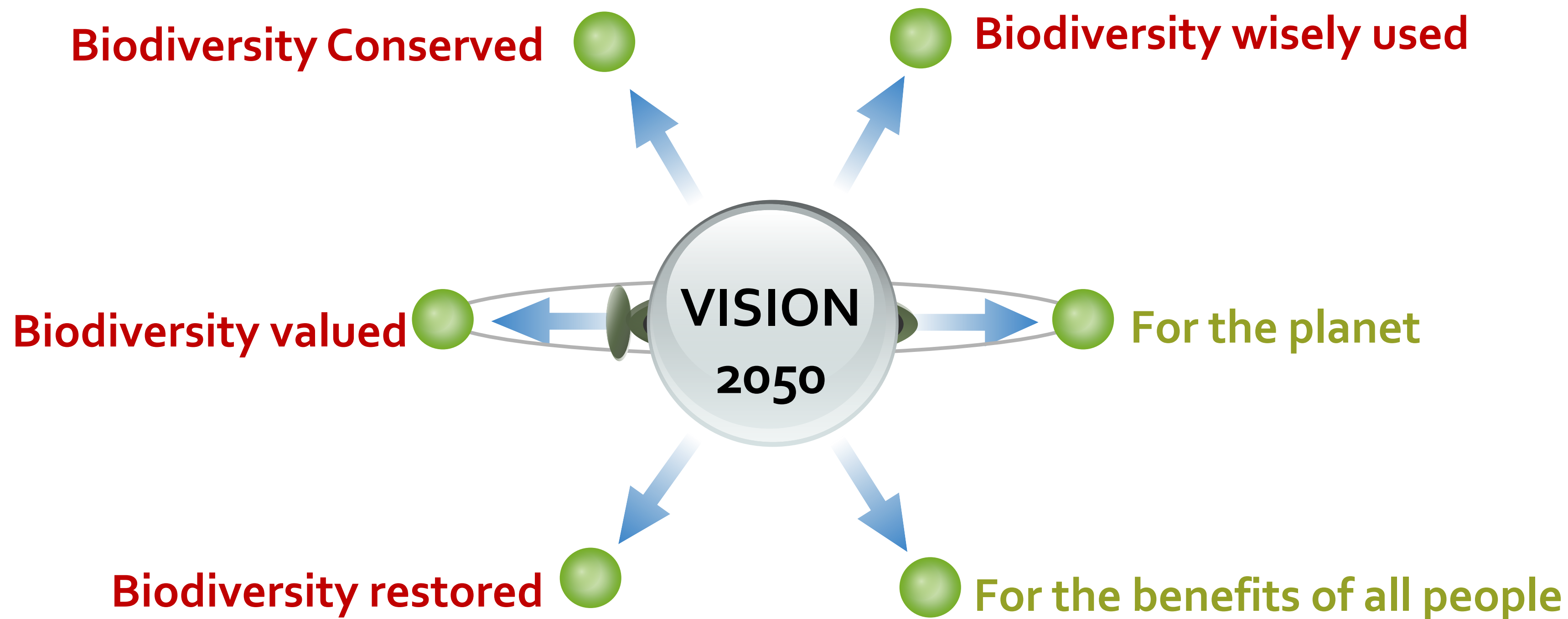




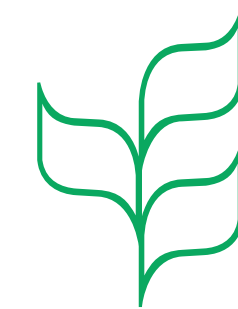
# Operationalise 2050 Vision

*"Living in Harmony with Nature" where*

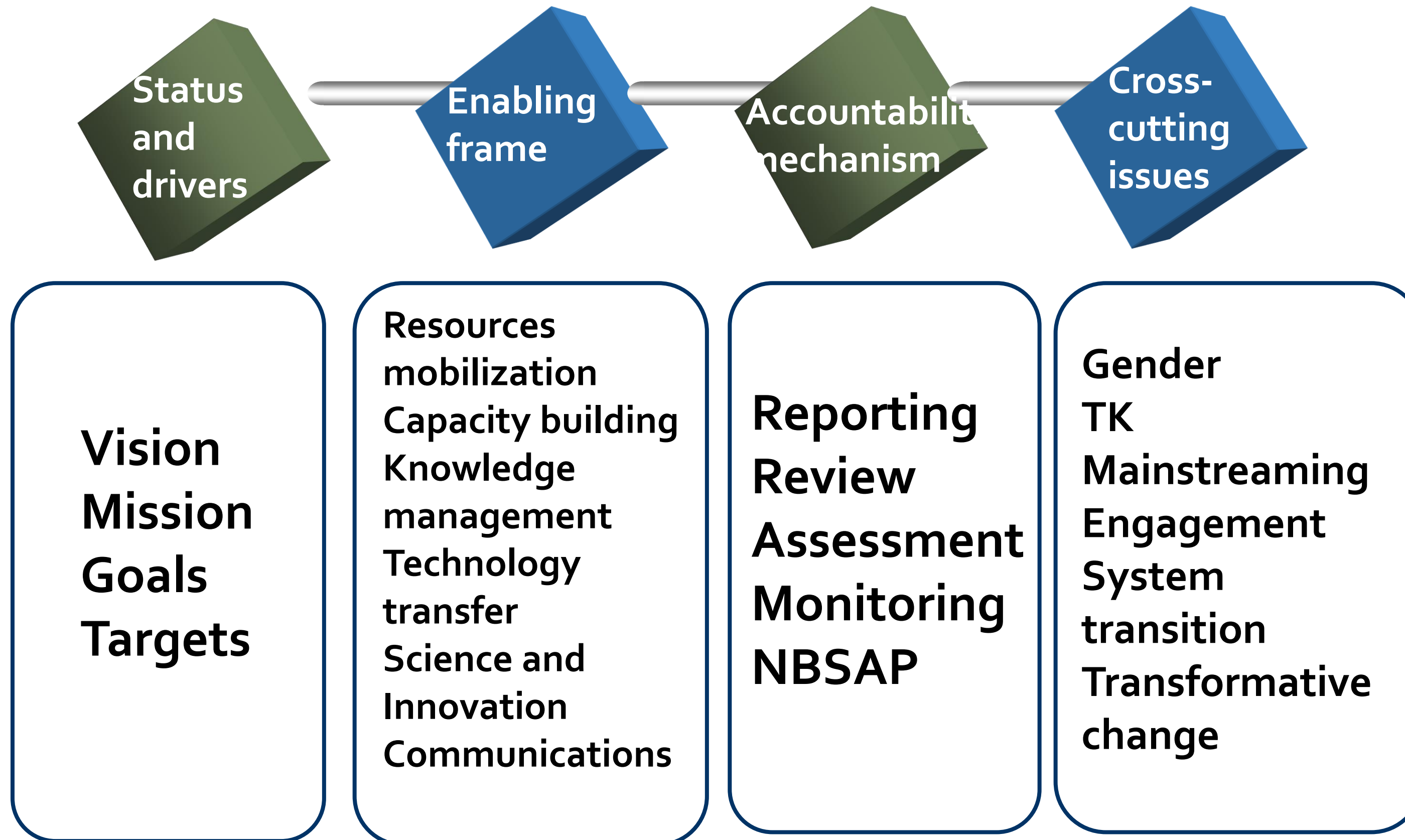

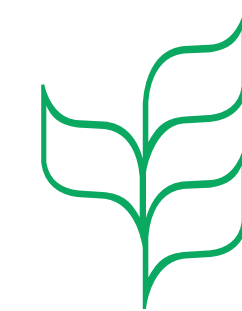

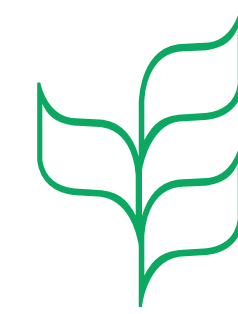
## Action Agenda commitments
