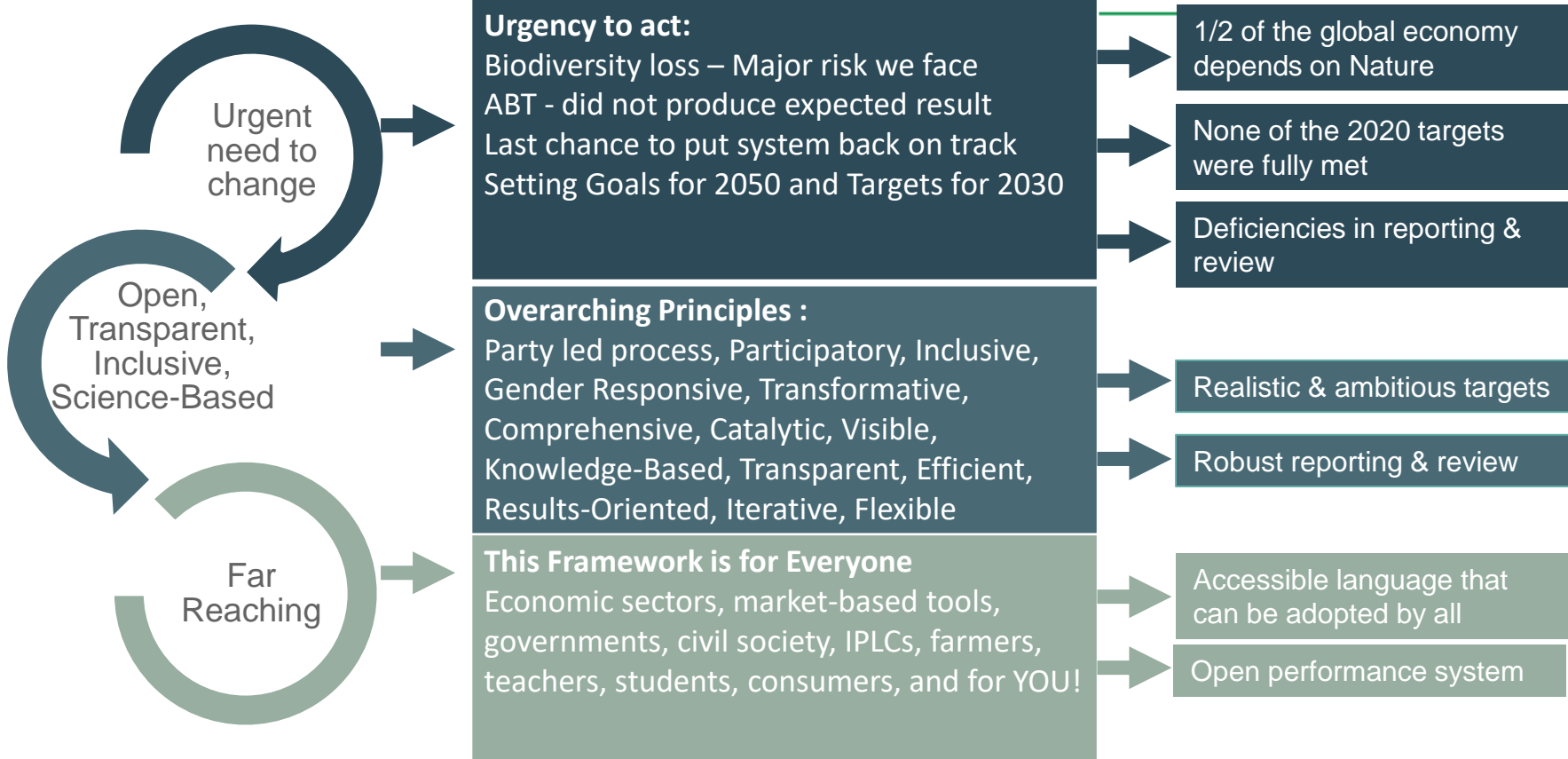

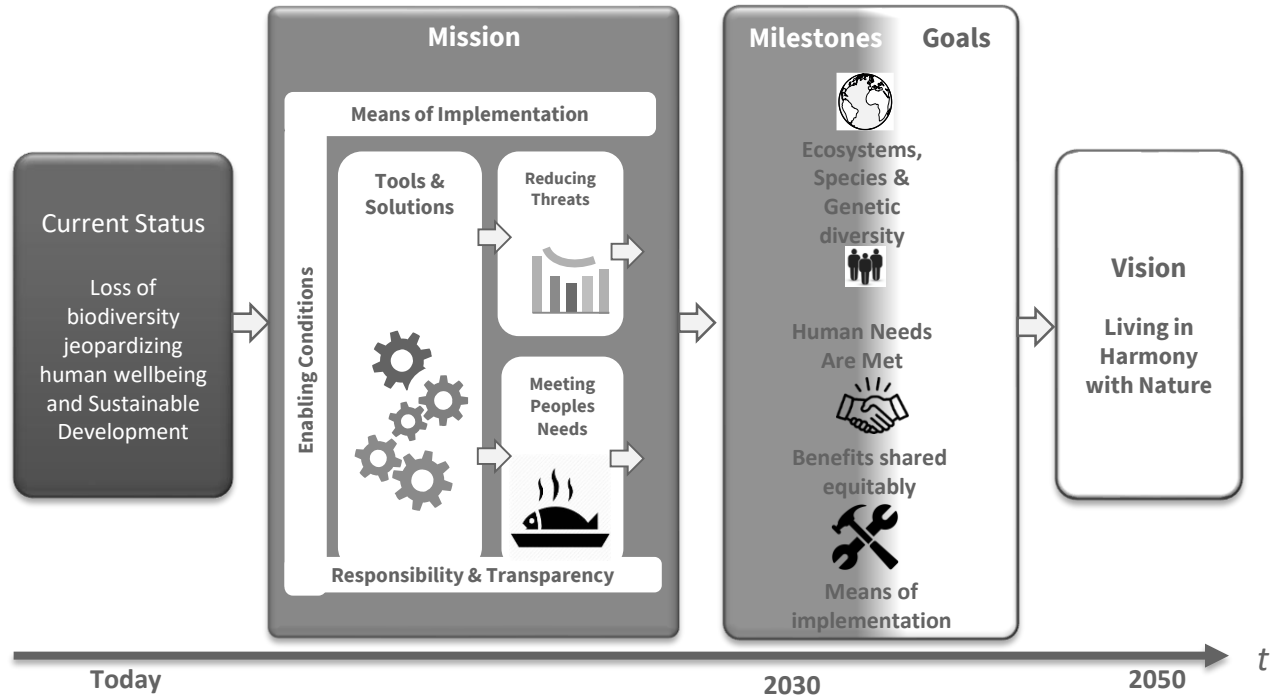

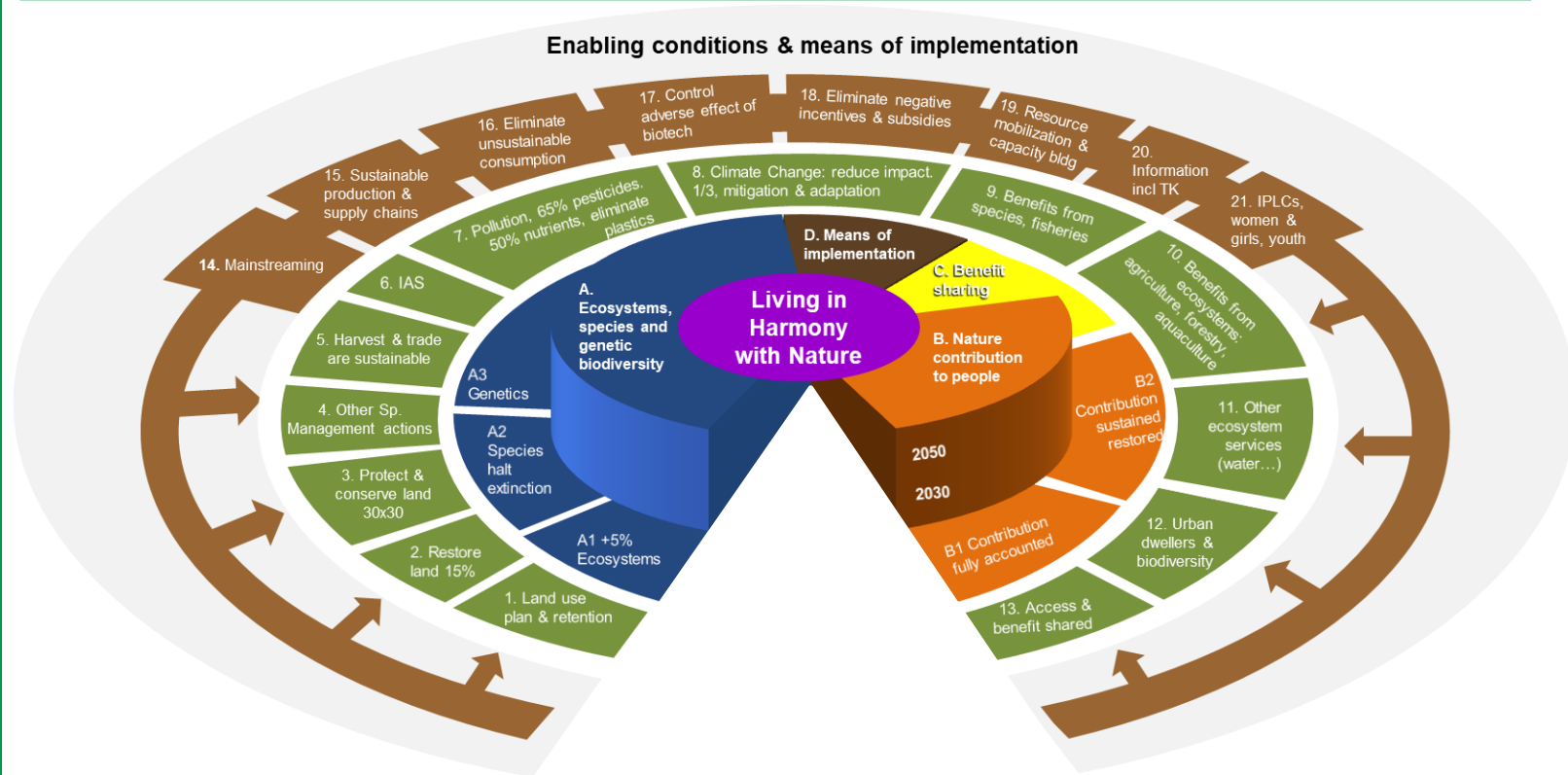

Targets

T3

Conserve and protect at least 30% of Earth's lands and oceans

T8

Minimize impact of climate change and ensure all mitigation and adaptation efforts avoid negative impacts on biodiversity

T14

Fully integrate biodiversity values into policies, regulations, planning, across all sectors of economy

T5

Harvesting, trade and use of wild species is sustainable, legal and safe for human health

T9

Ensure benefits for people through sustainable management of wild species

T15

Businesses from all sizes and sectors to assess and report on dependencies and impacts on biodiversity and progressively reduce impacts

T6

Invasive alien species management to prevent or reduce introduction by at least 50 %

T10

All areas under agriculture, aquaculture and forestry are managed sustainably

T16

Sustainable consumption and production and reduction of waste and overconsumption

T7

Reduce pollution from all sources to levels that are not harmful for biodiversity

T13

Access to genetic resources and fair and equitable sharing of benefits

T18

Redirect, repurpose, reform or eliminate incentives harmful for biodiversity
