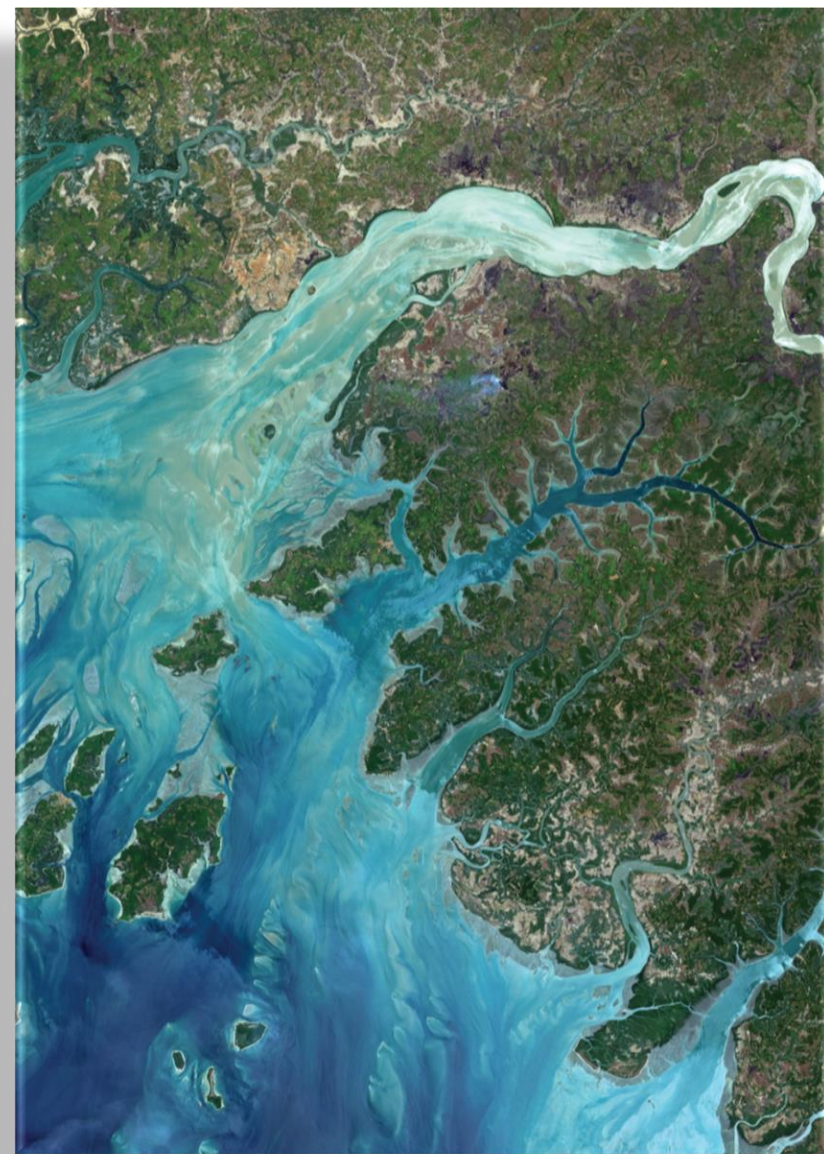
## Key areas of work



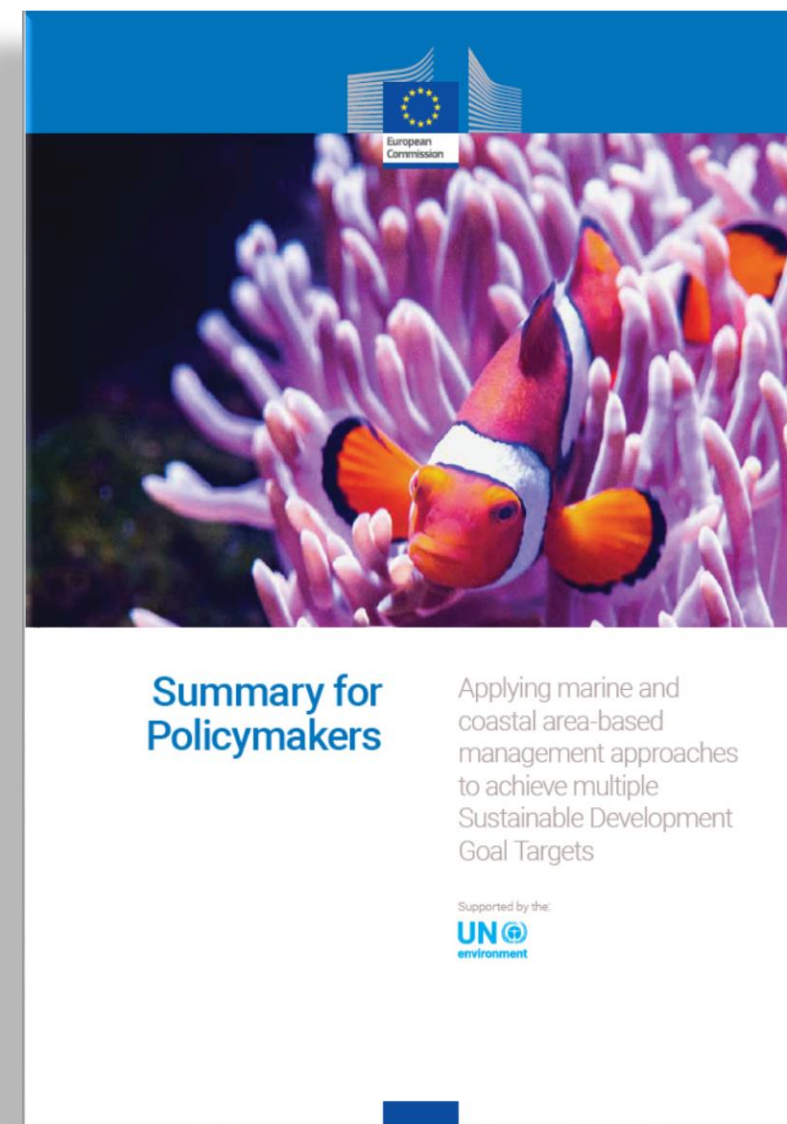
